- **Foreign to Appear in MECEE-BL-2023** : Those Students Who have Qualified Neet – In Academic Year 2021-2022-2023 Below Score 137 Need to Sit For Exam and Qualify to get Seat In Their Desired College .(**As Neet Is Valid For Three years as per National Medical Council –India**)
- **Foreign No to Appear in MECEE-BL-2023 But passes national Level Entrances Exam Of respective Country** – Students Who Have Score above 137 doesn't Need to Seat for Exam can Apply Direct Through Neet Score. Admission is based on NEET UG - 2023 Score 137 & above and students must have completed 10+2 with 50% Marks in PCB each subjects.

The selection is based on the merit list.
